Section 96 of the Offshore Petroleum and Greenhouse Gas Storage (Resource Management and Administration) Regulations 2025 (RMA Regulations) applies to a titleholder if there is a well operations management plan (WOMP) that is in force for a well in the title area at the end of any of the following periods:

- a. the period of 12 months beginning on the day that NOPSEMA accepted the plan under section 79
- b. each subsequent period of 12 months.

The titleholder must submit a written report (an annual well integrity report) for the 12 month period, that includes the information specified in this form, within 14 days after the end of the period.

A separate form should be used for each titleholder WOMP.
